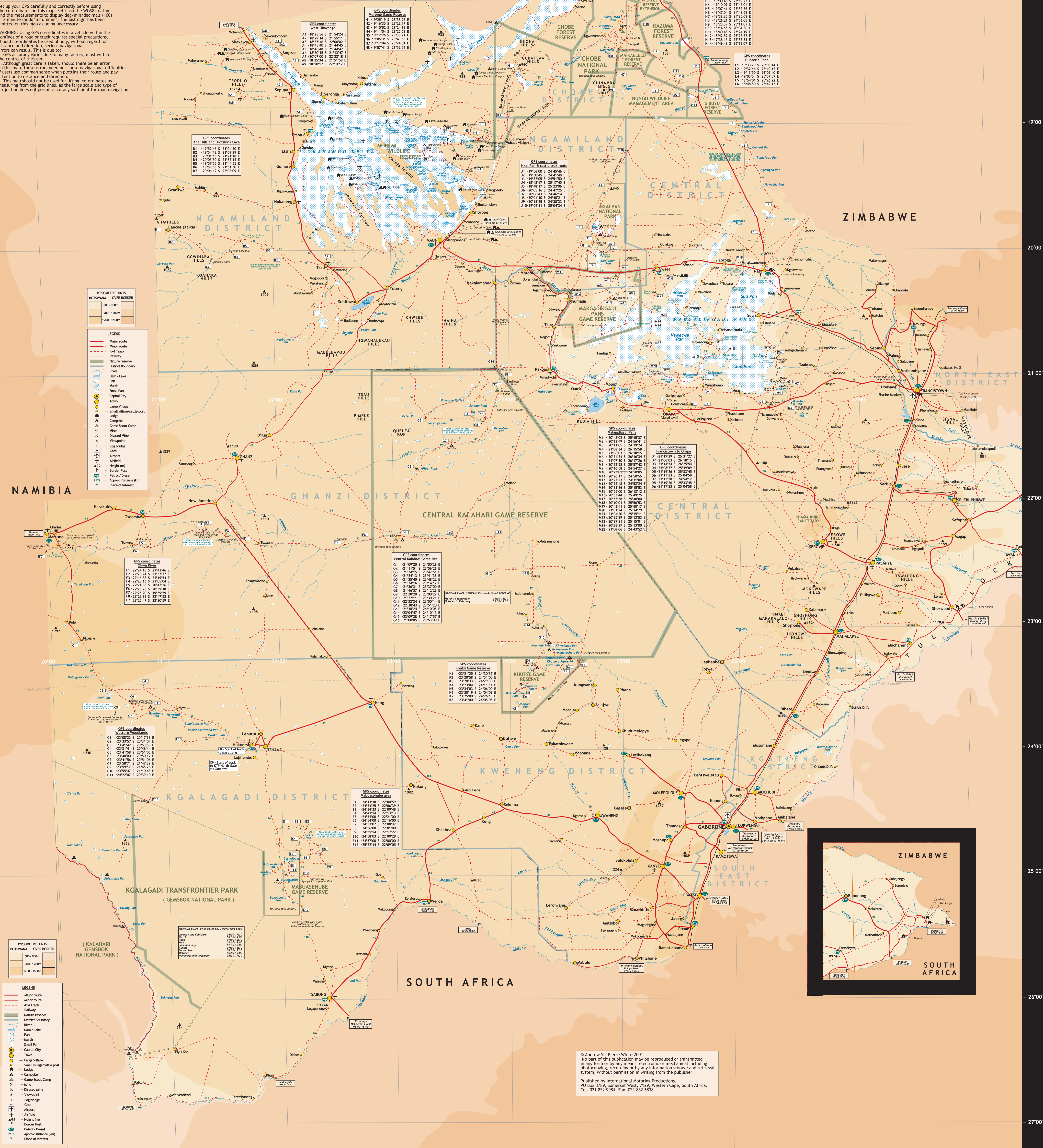

IMPORTANT NOTE TO GPS USERS

Set up your GPS carefully and correctly before using the co-ordinates on this map. Set it on the WGS84 datum and the measurements to display (deg/min/decimals/1000) of a minute (hddd mm.mmm) The last digit has been omitted on this map as being unnecessary.

WARNING: Using GPS co-ordinates in a vehicle within the confines of a road or track requires special precautions. Should co-ordinates be used blindly, without regard for distance and direction, serious navigational errors can result. This is due to:

1. GPS accuracy varies due to many factors, most within the control of the user.
2. Although great care is taken, should there be an error on this map, these errors need not cause navigational difficulties if users use common sense when plotting their route and pay attention to distance and direction.
3. This map should not be used for lifting co-ordinates by measuring from the grid lines, as the large scale and type of projection does not permit accuracy sufficient for road navigation.
